

The Story of Love is Eternal

- The beginning or our story is not the beginning of *the story*. When heaven and earth came into existence God was already there (Genesis 1:1).
- Love has a story and it's eternal. It's the big story that all others fit into.
- The story gets twisted when we assume wrong starting points.

Read Jeremiah 31:3 and 1 Corinthians 13:8-13

Attributes of God- The story of love is the story of God, who is love (1 John 4:8). To better understand the big story, we must seek a better understanding of God.

God is...

Eternal (Psalm 90:2), Unchanging (Malachi 3:6), Self-Sufficient (John 5:26), Omnipotent (Jeremiah 32:17), Omniscient (Isaiah 46:9-10), Omnipresent (Psalm 139:7-10), Wise (Romans 11:33), Faithful (Deut. 7:9), Good (Psalm 34:8), Just (Deut. 32:4), Gracious (Psalm 145:8), Holy (Rev. 4:8), Glorious (Rev. 19:1)

Rather than determining God's character through our experience we should allow the true character of God to give meaning to our experience. How do you do this? Is it a struggle? Is it liberating?

Other-Centered Love *Before* There Were Others
