

## **Eternal Destruction of the Wicked (Revelation 20:7-15)**

How does the destruction of the wicked promote an eternity of love? (Revelation 20:7-15)

**Alarming:** Rev. 20:10; 14:11; Matt.3:12;13:42,50; Mark 9:48; Is. 66:24

The wicked do not receive *immortality* so they can't exist forever.

- Immortality is given at the first resurrection. 1 Cor.15:50-54
- Lake of fire is the second death. Revelation 20:14
- The eternal reality of the wicked is contrasted with the eternal <u>life</u> of the righteous.

Romans 6:23; Matthew 7:13,14; 18:9; 25:46; Daniel 12:2; Mark 9:43, 45

God prevents sin from gaining eternal life. Gen 3:22-24

The wicked come to an **end**. Mal. 4:1,3 Ps. 37:10,20; Na. 1:9

- Wicked are <u>consumed</u> in the fires of judgment. Rev. 20:9
- The wicked will be <u>destroyed</u>-Philippians 3:19; 2 Peter 3:7; 2 Thessalonians 1:8,9; Matthew 7:13,14
- God destroys both body and soul in hell. Matthew 10:28

Destruction is reserved for the day of judgment.

2 Peter 2:4; 3:7; Matthew 13:40

- The final judgment is at end of the 1000 years. Rev. 20:7-10
- The wicked are dead during the 1000 years. Rev. 20:5

## **Eternal Life of the Righteous (Revelation 21:1-22:6)**

How does the home of the righteous promote an eternity of love? Revelation 21:1-22:6

- The Holy City is *prepared as a bride* for her husband. 21:2
- God will <u>dwell</u> with His people forever. 21:3; 22:3-5
- The former things will have <u>passed away</u>. (21:4)
