

Here are some ways for you to engage with this study beyond the Sabbath sermons!

Online

Journal

Use the Kingdom Journal to record your notes from the sermon and your weekly reading. The journal is available in print in the lobby and downloadable online.

Bible Reading

Follow the weekly reading schedule! The sermons will not cover every verse. So, we have mapped out a reading guide that does catch every verse and will keep you on track with the study.

Prayer

Pray Kingdom Prayers. The series title is “Your Kingdom Come”. It is also our prayer during this study. Jesus taught us to pray like this in the Lord’s Prayer, in Matthew 6:10, “Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.” Each week there will be a specific way that you see a need for God’s kingdom to come in your life or in our church. Make this your application goal each week, to discern how you need to be praying for and pursuing the kingdom. Let the message and the weekly reading inform that prayer.

Do additional reading! The book *Desire of Ages* is a great companion to the gospels. There are many other books that will help you do deeper in the study of Matthew.
